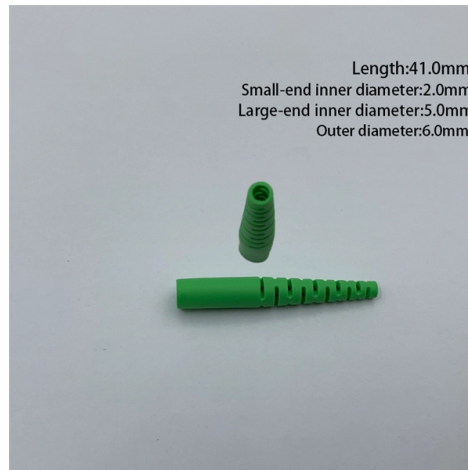

Overview

The National Electrical Code establishes specific minimum distances when communications cables must run near power and light circuits. This practice is mandatory for two distinct reasons: ensuring the safety of the structure and its occupants, and preserving the integrity of sensitive data. Maintaining proper separation between power, data, and limited energy cabling is foundational to system performance, safety, and code compliance. For the installation of the fiber optic cable, a minimum vertical distance of 1.80m in medium voltage line and 0.60m in low voltage line must be considered.
