It receives power from the main electrical supply and divides it into separate circuits, each. Longer answer: Nothing ever requires a main breaker in any panel of any description. There are rules that say that all conductors must be protected against overcurrent, and other similar rules about panels, and still other rules about transformer secondary windings. Make sure the breaker matches what it protects. This stops fires and helps everything work right. Follow electrical codes like NEC for safety. Use UL/CE-certified parts and record installation details for future inspections.
