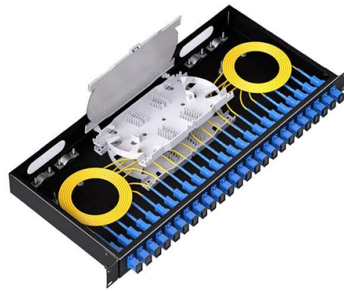


Fiber distribution box connected incorrectly
