### Overview

General Consideration: It is generally not recommended to run fiber optic cables in the same conduit as electrical power cables. This is due to several potential risks and complications that can arise from such an arrangement. Electrical Interference: Electrical cables can produce electromagnetic. We now need to put a data switch at the generator yard but don't have any other raceway going to the generator yard except the 2" conduit for the Generator Annunciator. My original plan was to trench new conduit and run CAT8, but given that the existing run is all "customer side" and installed by the former.
