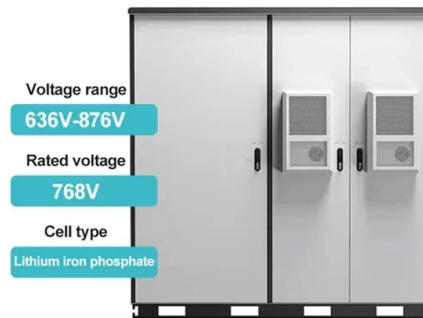


How many pigtails are needed for the optical module

A fiber optic pigtail is a short, usually unjacketed, optical fiber cable that has a factory-installed connector on one end and a length of exposed fiber at the other. The connector end can be linked directly to network equipment, while the exposed end can be spliced to another fiber optic cable.
