

How to connect a power distribution box in Fiji



Overview

In Fiji, they use Type I power plugs and outlets. The voltage is 240V, and the frequency is 50Hz. Their plugs and outlets are different from the Type A and B ones we use back in the States. Need a travel adapter?

Yes, you do need a. But the good news is that Fiji's electrical system is straightforward, the adapter you need is widely available, and with a small amount of preparation you can keep everything charged for the duration of your trip — even on outer islands where power is not continuous. Here is everything you need to. What most travellers need to know is that Fiji uses an electrical current of 240 volts 50 Hz and accepts Type I (i) plugs, so if your appliances don't fit the electrical outlets and/or require a different voltage or frequency, then you're going to need a travel adapter and maybe even a convertor. These plugs have 2 long, oblique blades that form into an upsidedown V-shape (seen sometimes with a third grounding pin in the same shape); They are generally used in Pacific Island countries.
