To install an OPGW joint box, position it on the inner side of the tower at a height of 8 to 10 meters. This ensures both protection and accessibility, which are vital for long-term system reliability.

While fiber optic cables generally are all dielectric and carry no electrical power, it may be necessary to work in areas that have installed electrical power cables and hardware.

SECTION 635 PULL, SPLICE, AND JUNCTION BOXES

For fiber optic cable applications, provide pull boxes with nominal cover dimensions of 24 inches wide by 36 inches long or larger and no less than 24 inches deep.

Install mounted junction boxes in accordance with Standard Plans, Index 676-010. Ensure that the bottom surface of pole mounted junction boxes is a minimum of 4 feet above the finished grade.
