Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the primary source of electrical energy from the mains supply. This manual is for electronic distribution only and is designed to provide you with the most current information on the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power's (Department) service equipment and installation requirements. This apparatus has a main breaker, which can cut power to the entire house, and as many circuit breakers as there are circuits in the house. The bare wire is connected to one or more long metal bars driven into the ground, or to a wire buried in the foundation, or sometimes to the water supply pipe.
