Hanging bars have a slotted strut channel that you suspend from 1/2"-13 threaded rod; the tray rests on. They support up to 280 lbs. When a cable tray system is installed in a prominent location, a maximum simple beam deflection of 1/200 of support span can be used as a guideline to minimize visual deflection. Cable racks (also called cable trays or cable support systems) are essential structural elements used in industrial plants, substations, commercial buildings, and infrastructure projects. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require.
