BBU have DSP (Digital signal processor) that process the conversion of signals between analog and digital. A Baseband Unit (BBU) is a key component in a cellular network, particularly in the Radio Access Network (RAN). It is a device that processes baseband signals, which are the original frequencies of a data transmission before it is modulated onto a radio frequency (RF) carrier wave for broadcast. The baseband is the original frequency spectrum of a transmission signal before it is modulated. In a telecom system, a BBU.
